

Minutes of Annual Parish Assembly for Skelton.

Held in the Skelton Village Hall on Thursday 28th April 2016.

The meeting commenced at 7 00 p.m.

- 16.01** Present
Parish Councillors: Watt (in the chair), Linfoot, Lumley, Hayton
Parishioners: 4, Clerk to the Parish Council.
- 16.02.** Apologies for absence - Parish Councillors A Mansell and L Mansell
- 16.03.** It was proposed and seconded by parishioners and unanimously agreed that the minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 23rd April 2015, which had been published with the notice of the meeting as required by law, be approved and signed by the Chairman as a true record.
- 16.04.** The Chairman read his annual report from the Parish Council. The report is attached.
- 16.05.** Village Hall
The accounts were presented and are attached.
The major work done on the Hall this past year has been the installation of a de-humidifier to resolve the problem of damp. A water boiler was also installed in the kitchen. This coming year it is planned to have the chimney stack re-pointed.
- 16.06.** Friends of Skelton Pond
The group's annual report and accounts were presented and are attached.
A lot of effort this year has been put into clearing the invasive reeds.
- 16.07.** The Clerk to the Parish Council gave a brief financial report on the provisional, un-audited accounts of the Parish Council for the year ended 31st March 2016 and of the Council Assets as at 31st March 2016.
The meeting confirmed the list of village assets.
- 16.08.** The following matters raised by parishioners.
1. Potholes on Pasture Close – it was agreed that the Parish Clerk would report them to the City.
 2. Councillor Stead, on behalf of the School, asked if there were any objections to the PTA moving the salt bin from outside the School to the top of Brecks Lane. There were no objections.
